





- Brian is a solid teacher. I recommend assigning more homework. Also, the class could have (and should have!) covered 2-3x the material it actually did. A topology class that ends on compactness is kinda a joke.
- Brian is an excellent instructor and really connects with his students. I know that he has pushed me to think outside the box, and I have learned a lot from this course. I had him for Math 521 as well, and I have really appreciated his teaching style and his availability.
- There was quite a bit of overlap with my introductory analysis class which made some of topics a little less challenging than they might've otherwise been for me, but Brian did a good job with finding challenging, interesting problems that got me to engage with these ideas more deeply.

- Dr. Hepler presents the material from the textbook very well and also gives new examples. My one complaint would be that his syllabus said that there would be 10 homeworks, but in actuality there were only 4. So it was much harder for me to stay disciplined and updated with the course material and there was less opportunity to improve your grade. Also grades on the homework came in extremely slow (one was almost 2 months after it was submitted), but I don't know whether that was on him or the grader.
